



NOTICE FOR INVITATION OF BIDS



CONSTRUCTION OF REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE WORKSHOP FOR THE WSSP SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT EQUIPMENT AND MACHINERY PESHAWAR (Remaining work)

The USAID has provided funds to finance the cost of rehabilitation / construction of drains with allied works of "Construction of Repair and Maintenance workshop for the WSSP solid waste management equipment and machinery Peshawar" under Municipal Services Program (MSP) through Project Management Unit (PMU), Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, to make eligible payment under the Contract for which this Invitation of Bids is issued. The detail is as under:

Construction of Repair and Maintenance Workshop for the WSSP solid waste management equipment and machinery Peshawar. (Remaining Works) along with Procurement & Installation of different Systems/Equipment in the premises of WORKSHOP.

Estimated Cost: Rs 187,797,349

Project Management Unit (PMU) invites sealed bids for the above works on "Single Stage Two Envelopes" bidding process, under KPPRA Rules, from all the eligible interested Contractors / Firms having relevant experience of carrying-out similar works and registration with Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) Category C-2 & above having specialization code ME 02 (Fire alarm/fighting), ME 05 (workshop), EE02 (CCTV), EE07 (Telephone System), EE11 (Solar) and registered / enlisted with the MSP, LGE & RD Department KPK Peshawar with up to date renewal. Interested contractor must register themselves with MSP LGE & RDD two days prior to the closing date of bid submission. The bidders must be registered with KP Revenue Authority (KPPRA).

Set of Bid documents for said work can be obtained from the office of the Project Director, PMU, 43-B/1 Sahibzada Abdul Qayyum Khan Road, University Town, Peshawar from **January 4, 2021 to January 20, 2021** (both days inclusive) between 9:00 A.M to 5.00 PM on submission of written request on bidder's letterhead and payment of prescribed bidding Documents fee (non-refundable) of **Rs.2,000 per set** in favor of PD, PMU, Municipal Services Program, Town-1, Peshawar. The pre-bid meeting will be held on **January 14, 2020 at 11:00 AM** in PMU office.

The bidders are advised to visit the site before submission of bids. Bids, comprising Technical & Financial Bids, must be submitted in separate sealed envelopes with clear marking of "TECHNICAL BID" & "FINANCIAL BID" which will be received back on or before **January 21, 2021 up to 12:00 P.M** in office of the PD, PMU. Technical Bids of the participating bidders will be opened **on the same day at 12:30 P.M**, by the Bid Opening Committee in presence of participating bidders or their authorized representatives who wish to be present. In case bids submission / opening day declared a holiday the same will be submitted / opened on the next working day.

02% earnest money in the shape of Call Deposit/CDR in the name of Project Director, Project Management Unit (MSP) Local Government, Election and Rural Development, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar will be submitted along with Financial Bid. An affidavit on stamp paper must be attached with technical Bid stating that the required amount of Bid security is attached with financial Bid.

All applicable taxes including GST etc. as per Government Rules, shall be included in offered prices.

Bidding shall be done on **Above / Below** basis on BOQ. Bids should be carefully & neatly filled and signed by the bidders. Incomplete Bids and overwritten or conditional Bids shall not be entertained. Contractors already working with MSP KP are required to furnish certificate regarding satisfactory performance duly signed by the Engineer MSP KP. An affidavit (certificate) has to be submitted by the contractor for not involving in any litigation with the department. Certificate issued by the employer regarding satisfactory completion of works by the firm during last ten years is also required.

No tender will be issued on the opening date of tenders. This advertisement/tender documents can also be downloaded from PMU MSP website (www.mspkp.gov.pk) and KPPRA website.
